

# New Zealand Certificate in Collision Repair

(Structural Repair)

Level 5



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Designed in consultation with industry, this programme will provide experienced non-structural collision repairers with the skills and knowledge required to advance their career to structural repair positions.

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### **Programme outline**

This work-based programme is expected to take 14 months to complete.

The training programme includes a mix of practical training and assessment, undertaken in the workplace, and eLearning, allowing you to complete theory elements of the programme at your own pace. You will have access to videos, interactive simulations and theory assessments, which can be easily accessed at any time and from any device – mobile phone, tablet or PC.

### **Entry requirements**

You must be employed full-time in the industry and have completed the New Zealand Certificate in Collision Repair (Non-Structural Repair) (Level 4), or provide evidence of equivalent skills and knowledge, to enrol in this programme.

### **2024 programme fee**

\$662 (excluding GST). Note this is a fixed fee and is non-refundable.
