

MITO's training programme will provide you with the skills and knowledge to safely and competently operate heavy rigid vehicles or heavy combination vehicles.

Designed in consultation with industry, this programme goes beyond vehicle licence requirements to enable improved job performance and enhanced employment opportunities – whether you're new to the commercial road transport industry or an existing heavy vehicle driver.

Programme outline

This Level 3 work-based programme is expected to take 15 months to complete.

The training programme includes a mix of practical training and assessment, undertaken in the workplace, and eLearning, allowing you to complete theory elements of the programme at your own pace. You will have access to videos, learning activities and course assessments, which can be easily accessed at any time and from any device – mobile phone, tablet or PC.

Entry requirements

You must be employed full-time in the commercial road transport industry and hold the correct vehicle licence required to enrol in this programme.

2024 programme fee

\$400 (excluding GST). Note this is a fixed fee and is non-refundable.
